

Scholarship Program for Sons and Daughters of Employees of Roseburg Forest Products Co.

Intended for: Sons and daughters of employees of Roseburg Forest Products Co. as they pursue education beyond high school.

Number awarded: Each year, up to 10% of all eligible dependents are selected to receive a Ford Sons & Daughters Scholarship.

ELIGIBILITY

Applicant must:

- Be a **dependent child or stepchild** of an employee of Roseburg Forest Products Co. The employee must be full time and have been employed by Roseburg Forest Products Co. for a minimum of 18 months as of March 1 of the application year.
- Be **21 years old or younger** as of March 1 of the application year. If selected, recipients may continue in the program beyond age 21.
- **Attend full time, on campus**, beginning fall of the application year.
- **Not have previously earned** a bachelor's degree.
- Plan to pursue a **2-year, 4-year or technical degree**.

Financial need is considered, but is not a requirement element.

Applicants are encouraged to complete a *Free Application for Federal Student Aid* (FAFSA) as they may be eligible for other forms of financial aid.



SELECTION CRITERIA

Each successful candidate will demonstrate:

- **A concern for others** through contributions to volunteer projects and/or family needs.
- **Good character.**
- **Work ethic.** Responsibility, initiative and skill-building through paid or unpaid work experiences.
- **An ability to clearly communicate** personal strengths and goals both in writing and verbally.
- **An ability to succeed academically** in college as demonstrated by a high school or college GPA, coursework and standardized test scores.
- **A sound education plan.**

All eligible applicants are interviewed.

ELIGIBLE INSTITUTIONS

Eligible institutions include any 2-year or 4-year, public or private, non-profit or for-profit, post-secondary institution in the United States that is eligible to participate in federal Title IV student financial aid programs.

SCHOLARSHIP AMOUNT

Scholarship award amounts for the Ford Sons & Daughters Program depend on the type of college the recipient is attending. A recipient enrolled in a 2-year college or program will receive an award amount of \$3,000 each academic year. A recipient enrolled in a 4-year college or program will receive an award amount of \$5,000 each academic year. This scholarship can be renewed annually if the student makes satisfactory academic progress and meets other program requirements.

DEADLINE

All application materials must be submitted online by 5 pm PST on March 1 of each year.
